What Lube??



The question is often asked as to which or what kind of lubricant should be used with MAXAM Bearings. The simple answer is "whatever lubricant that is being used now". Actually, MAXAM can be used with grease, oil, air oil, etc., and it will require less of it. A steel mill which uses MAXAM in their casters found that an added benefit, which they experienced in addition to much longer operational life, was that their lubricant usage decreased, providing them added savings.

Besides being able to run on traditional lubricants, such as those mentioned above, MAXAM Bearings have run on unconventional lubricating agents like water, sludge and even some mild acids. How?? The MAXAM process treated material which the bearings are made from does not rust or corrode.

Lastly, MAXAM's have been known to continue to operate for what would be considered extended periods of time when lubrication is absent for some reason.
